

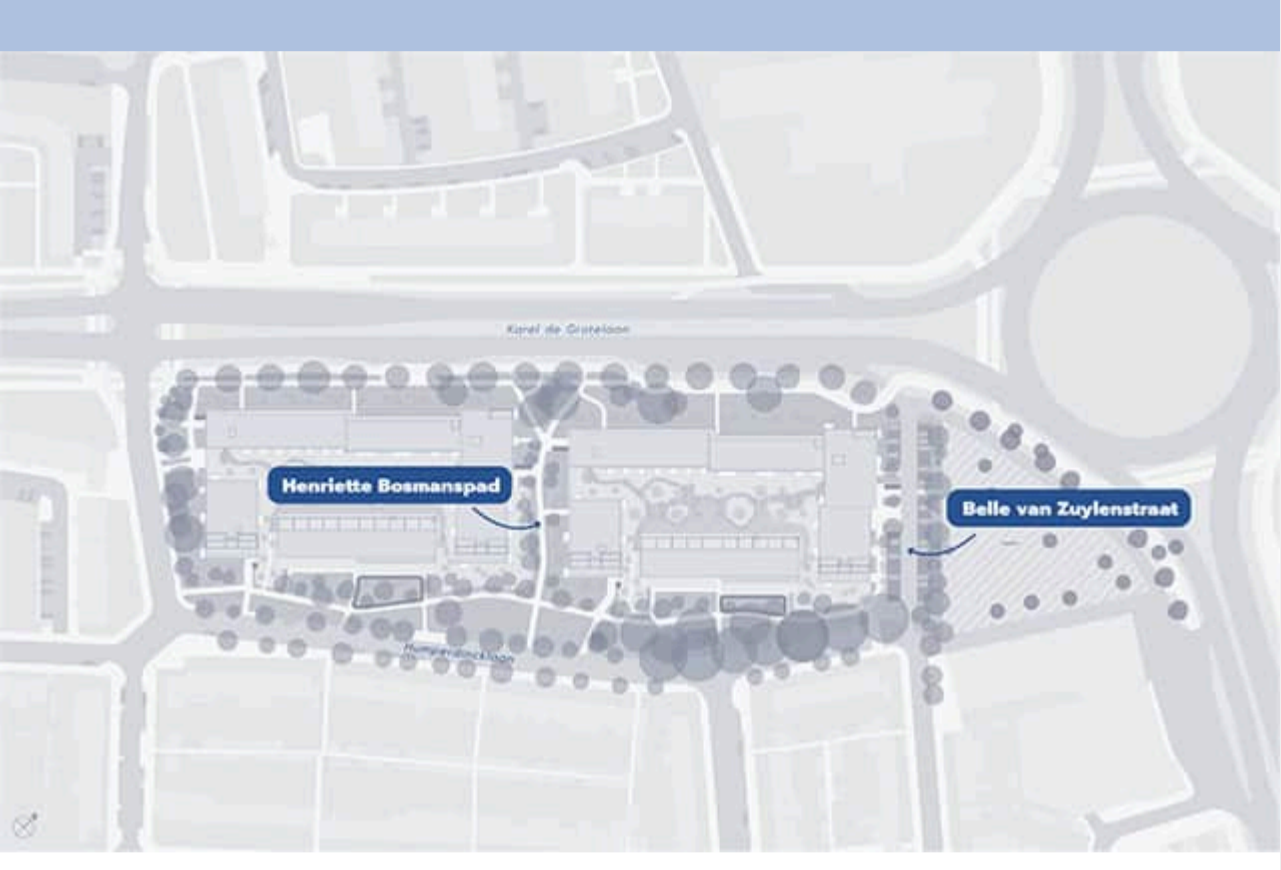
Something is going to happen on the Humperdincklaan

The street names of INCK

In INCK on the Humperdincklaan, there will be two new streets. The new street names have been determined by the municipality, taking musical inspiration.

The low-traffic central street will be called Henriette Bosmanspad, named after the well-known Dutch composer who gained acclaim in the 20th century with her impressive piano compositions. On the side of the square near the traffic circle will be the Belle van Zuylenstraat, an ode to the versatile Belle van Zuylen (also known as Isabelle de Charrière). She was known not only for her literary work, but also for her musical compositions.

With these street names, the composers will have a place where their legacies can continue to resonate in a new, vibrant living environment.



Progress of the zoning plan

The zoning plan is currently under review by the State Council. A hearing for the preliminary injunction for demolition of the International School will take place in November 2024. The ruling is expected to be approximately six weeks later. For the appeal in the main proceedings has not yet been scheduled.

Unfortunately, these proceedings do not contribute to the smooth progress of the plan and create uncertainty regarding the start of construction. We will of course continue to work on the realization of this new building plan with a positive attitude and confidence and will keep you informed about the progress and planning in the meantime.



The demolition

Demolition of the former International School is approaching. Asbestos removal from the building will begin within two weeks, and once that is complete, the actual demolition will start. The homes in the immediate vicinity are undergoing structural inspection. Affected residents have already received a letter about this from the Hanselman Group.

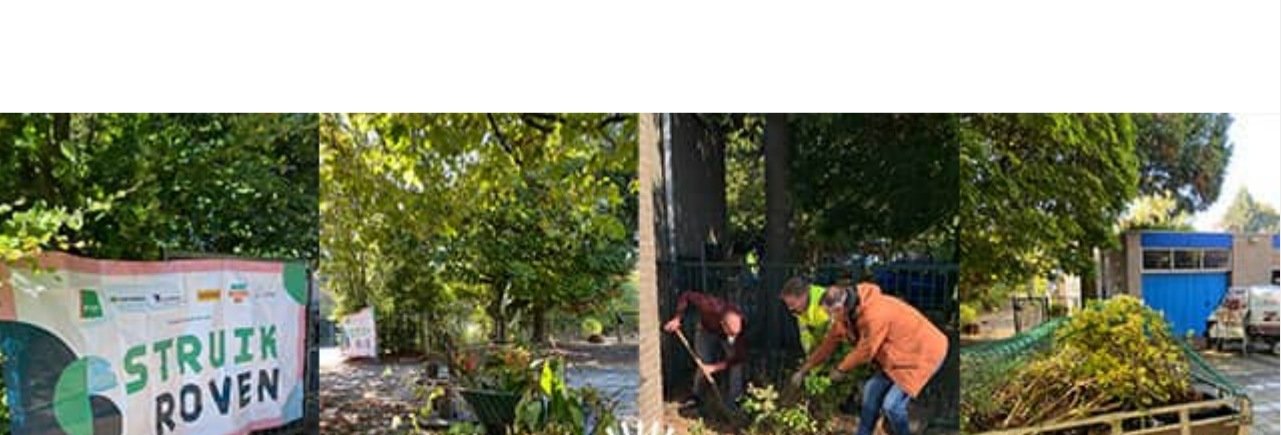
A walk-in meeting was recently held for direct residents to ask questions. The asbestos removal and demolition work is expected to take about three months. Woonbedrijf and Heijmans are working to minimize disruption to the Humperdincklaan as much as possible during the demolition process.



Saving plants together
